hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981  
modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by adding the bridleway:

Beginning on Fleming Road opposite the junction with Ringlemere Lane (Ordnance Survey  
grid reference TR29635669), initially south along the eastern boundary of a pumping  
station, then turning south-southwest and then (shortly after passing a second pumping  
station) southwest for a distance of 690 metres to a junction with bridleway EE201  
adjacent to the southeast corner of a third pumping station (TR29025631); then continuing  
southwest, initially along the southern boundary of the third pumping station and then  
along the northern side of a headland, for a distance of 380 metres to join Sandwich Road  
at the corner adjacent to the southern entrance to a fourth pumping station (TR29015588).  
A total distance of 1,070 metres.
