Diversions of Footpath - Saltwood

We act for Mr. H. H. Cordy of Saltwood Lodge, Hythe, closely adjoining the Railway Embankment which is adjacent to the field where there is a diversion of footway. The diversion is from the middle of the field to the top of the field close to the embankment where we understand the footway will be shut in by a railing. We were surprised of this matter too late to take any objection as we understand Quarter Sessions approved the diversion on Tuesday last. We tried to get you on the telephone today but you were in court. We cannot find out definitely who was fixed with the duty of making and maintaining this way as we have seen the leases in case today it will be impossible in the winter, particularly in certain parts, if the footway is not made up and maintained, and the railings will prevent avoiding the quagmires. Would you be kind enough to let us know what provision is made in the Order for making up and maintenance i.e. who is to do it?
