hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by upgrading to restricted byway the footpath HE53 from the junction with Beards Hall Lane at TR23104330, to the junction with footpath HE183, then to a turning at a corner in Boyington Lane (formerly Lamper Lane) at TR22574319 (this is Way V: Street Lane).
