hereby apply for an order under section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981
modifying the definitive map and statement for the county of Kent by upgrading to a
bridleway part of the footpath ER85 which begins at a former gate on Upton Wood Road at
the property known as Upton Wood (Ordnance Survey grid reference TR25944684) and
proceeds for 820 metres in a north-westerly direction, partly enclosed, to reach Cox Hill
Road (TR25354741) just south of Diamond Farm.
